





ASSIGNMENT CONSENT AGREEMENT



THIS AGREEMENT made this 28 day of Nov, 1980 by, between and among Orievall Center for Biblical Studies, a Texas corporation, (hereinafter called Seller), and Christina M. Shaw (hereinafter called Buyer),

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Seller is the licensee of International broadcast station KGBI, Dallas, Texas (hereinafter called Station);

WHEREAS, Buyer desires to acquire Station;

WHEREAS, the consent of the Federal Communications Commission (hereinafter called Commission) is a condition precedent)

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein contained, the parties intending to be legally bound, do hereby agree as follows:

1) The consummation of this agreement shall not take place until after the Commission has issued its written consent to the assignment of the license for Station;

2) Seller for the consideration of one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) delivered with this agreement, and receipt of which is acknowledged by Seller by the execution of this agreement, does hereby agree, subject only to Federal Communications Commission approval, to assign its short-wave radio license, which it presently holds under the authority of the Federal Communications Commission, referenced in FCC files as: File No. DL123071SHU, to Buyer;

3) Buyer agrees to file all necessary documentation with the Federal Communications Commission required for application for FCC approval of this assignment. Buyer represents that she is a United States citizen and is legally qualified to be a licensee of the Federal Communications Commission;

4) Seller agrees to fully cooperate with Buyer and the Federal Communications Commission by expeditiously providing any additional information or documentation reasonably requested, and to otherwise use its best efforts to obtain a grant of this assignment.

5) Wherein Buyer has already provided consideration to Seller, consummation of this agreement shall take place automatically upon written notification of grant by the Federal Communications Commission. Parties agree that Buyer shall have authority to provide written notification of consummation to the Commission.

An application requesting Consent to Assignment of the license of KZIA(TV), Las Cruces, New Mexico, from Southwestern Broadcasting Co., Inc. to Two If By Sea Broadcasting Corporation pending at the Commission (FCC File No. BALCT-920406KJ) was dismissed without prejudice effective July 2, 1992 pursuant to a request by Southwestern Broadcasting Co., Inc.
