On July 9, National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) members of the Radio Executive Committee Steven Newberry, President and CEO, Commonwealth Broadcasting Corporation; Charles Warfield, President and COO, ICBC Broadcast Holdings, Inc.; and Caroline Beasley, Executive Vice President and CFO, Beasley Broadcast Group, together with the undersigned, met with Commissioner Jonathan S. Adelstein, his advisor Rudy Brioché and legal intern Shawn Donilon, as well as with Amy Blankenship, advisor to Commissioner Deborah Taylor Tate.

We discussed their concerns over several aspects of the Commission's recently issued Report and Notice of Proposed Rulemaking regarding Localism. In particular, the parties discussed the relative costs and benefits of reinstating obligations on broadcasters to locate a station's main studio within its community of license, to maintain radio station personnel on-site at all times. We also discussed the various ways in which broadcasters efficiently undertake ascertainment-like efforts in the absence of government regulation.

We also expressed our respective opposition and positions on the proposed merger of XM Satellite Radio and Sirius Satellite Radio.
