This office represents Entravision Communications Corporation ("Entravision").


On May 4, 2009, Mr. Walter F. Ulloa, the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Entravision, and the undersigned, participated in two meetings with the Commission staff concerning the above referenced proceeding. In one meeting, the Commission participants were Rebekah Goodheart, Royce Sherlock, Rosalee Chiasa, Marcia Glauber, Debra Sabourin, Elvis Stumbergs, William Beckwith, Julie Salovaara, Mania Baghdadi (by speakerphone) and Roy Stewart of the Media Bureau, Gardner Foster of the International Bureau, and Joel Rabinovitz of the Office of the General Counsel. In the other meeting, the Commission participants were Rick Chessen and Jamila Bess-Johnson of the Office of Acting Chairman Copps.

In the meetings, Mr. Ulloa and the undersigned addressed the above-referenced proceeding in general, and, in particular, the issues raised by Entravision in the Reply Comments it submitted in this proceeding. Entravision addressed and responded to questions concerning the subject of the current media market and the resources necessary for any entity to operate successfully the channels that Sirius-XM propose to lease. Entravision also offered its opinions on, reasoning for, and responded to questions concerning the following subjects: what entities should qualify to seek these channels, the need for cross-platform leases as opposed to leases of XM or Sirius channels, the number of channels that Entravision was capable of programming and wished to lease, and that either Sirius-XM or an independent board appointed by Sirius-XM should undertake the selection process subject to Commission review.
