Dear Ms. Dortch:

In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, this letter notifies the Commission that on June 17, 2009, Mel Karmazin, Patrick Donnelly and James Blitz of Sirius XM Radio Inc. ("Sirius XM") and Richard Wiley and Gregg Elias of Wiley Rein LLP, counsel for Sirius XM, met with Acting Chairman Copps, Rick Chessen and Jamila Bess Johnson.

During the meeting the participants discussed implementation of the merger condition requiring Sirius XM to enter into long-term leases or other agreements to provide a Qualified Entity or Entities rights to four percent of the full-time audio channels on the Sirius platform and on the XM platform. Sirius XM reaffirmed its willingness to make capacity available and to not be involved in the selection process consistent with its commitment made in the merger proceeding. The participants also discussed the need to implement the commitment in a constitutional manner. Sirius XM also expressed views consistent with those already in the record of this proceeding.
