On May 24, 2010, Patricia Coulter, CEO, the Urban League of Philadelphia; David Jefferson, CEO, JNET Communications, LLC; Johnathan Rodgers, CEO, TV One; and Payne Brown, Vice President of Strategic Initiatives, Comcast Corporation; and the undersigned met with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn and Rick Kaplan, Chief of Staff, Office of Commissioner Clyburn.

Mr. Brown highlighted Comcast's commitment to diversity through various ongoing initiatives. Comcast and its partners discussed their shared experiences to illustrate Comcast's support of diversity in many facets of its business, including community investment, supplier diversity, and programming diversity. Ms. Coulter described Comcast's support of the Urban League's efforts to improve the lives of African Americans through a multi-year partnership with a focus on job training. Mr. Jefferson, whose JNET Communications, LLC is a minority-owned company and one of Comcast's suppliers, discussed Comcast's early involvement in helping him build a business that currently employs over 600 people in urban areas. And Mr. Rodgers explained how Comcast helped to create TV One and provided support when others would not, noting that the network offers a broad range of lifestyle and entertainment programming designed primarily for African American audiences.
