Applicants described the process involved in responding to the Department of Justice's Second Request and Civil Investigative Demand.² Applicants also discussed the overlap between certain specific questions in the Second Request and CID and the Commission's Information Requests. Applicants described the ways data are typically kept within the companies and gave examples of practical issues relating to certain of the Information Requests. Applicants stressed the need to protect the confidentiality of documents and information produced in response to the Information Requests. Applicants raised the need to clarify certain of the instructions to the Information Requests. Applicants discussed logistical and technological format issues relating to the production of documents and information responsive to the Information Requests. Applicants requested that the Commission take their comments into account in considering the Information Requests.
