Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Wednesday, June 2, 2010, Kathleen Grillo of Verizon and John Scott of Verizon Wireless along with the undersigned of Wilkinson Barker Knauer, LLP, met with Bruce Gottlieb, Chief Counsel and Senior Legal Advisor to Chairman Genachowski, and Austin Schlick, General Counsel. The parties discussed both procedural and substantive issues raised in Verizon's petition for partial reconsideration and its other filings in the above-captioned proceeding.¹

In particular, Verizon representatives observed that adoption of the order in this proceeding lacked transparency and expressed significant reservations regarding the conditions prohibiting arrangements between SkyTerra and Verizon Wireless (and AT&T) without FCC approval. Verizon urged revocation of the company-specific conditions and expressed its opposition to any conditions that would subject dealings with Verizon Wireless to distinct restrictions or regulatory requirements. To the extent the Commission believes that conditions on the transaction are warranted, they should apply industry-wide.
