On June 23, 2010, CenturyLink and Qwest met in three separate meetings with Chairman Julius Genachowski, Priya Aiyar-Legal Advisor to Chairman Genachowski and Sharon Gillett, Chief of the Wireline Competition Bureau; with Commissioner Meredith Baker and Christi Shewman, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Baker; and, with Commissioner Robert McDowell, Christine Kurth, Legal Advisor-Commissioner McDowell and Molly Toohey, an intern in Commissioner McDowell's office. At all three meetings, CenturyLink was represented by Glen Post, Tom Gerke and David Bartlett; Qwest was represented by Ed Mueller, Steve Davis and Melissa Newman.

We discussed the merits of the pending merger of CenturyLink and Qwest. We noted that the merger will make the combined company more competitive on a national scale and will spur investment and innovation in the broadband market. All comments were consistent with the application filed in this docket.
