This is to inform you that on Thursday, July 1, 2010, S. Douglas Hutcheson, President and Chief Executive Officer of Leap Wireless International and Cricket Communications, Inc. (“together, Cricket”), and Robert J. Irving, Jr., Senior Vice President and General Counsel of Cricket, met with Federal Communications Commission Chairman Julius Genachowski at Cricket’s corporate offices in San Diego, CA.

During this meeting, Mssrs. Hutcheson and Irving discussed with Chairman Genachowski the current state of Cricket’s business and operations, its products and services, and its customer profile. The Cricket representatives also expressed views on wireless network management practices and techniques consistent with Cricket’s comments and reply comments in the above-referenced dockets, and reiterated the importance of a data roaming obligation to ensure seamless coverage for consumers.
