Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 6, 2010, Aparna Sridhar of Free Press and I met with Edward Lazarus, Bruce Gottlieb and Paul de Sa. This notice is submitted in compliance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules.

We discussed the strengths and weaknesses of the proposals for Open Internet rules made by broadband carriers and Internet edge companies in meetings at the Commission held in June.

We expressed our view that open Internet rules should extend to wireless broadband services. We stated that while the Commission should consider the infrastructure and capacity constraints specific to wireless and wireline delivery when determining the reasonableness of specific network management practices, the Commission should not apply two distinct sets of rules to broadband Internet access.

We expressed our belief that the FCC must immediately settle the jurisdictional issues that it has raised in the "Framework for Broadband Internet Service" Notice of Inquiry. Without a sound legal foundation, any policy framework developed by the Commission to preserve the open Internet and consumer choice online, could be unenforceable and consumers will be left unprotected.
