On Friday, July 16, 2010, A. Robert Pisano and Linda Kinney of Motion Picture Association of America, Kathy Garmezy of Director's Guild of America, Scott Harbinson of International Alliance of Theatrical Stage Employees, Gigi Sohn and Sherwin Siy of Public Knowledge, and David Sohn and Andrew McDiarmid from Center for Democracy & Technology had a discussion with Edward Lazarus, FCC Chief of Staff and Zachary Katz, Deputy Chief, FCC Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis. They discussed details relating to prospective legislation regarding open Internet principles. Specifically, the discussed items included:

- Concerns that open Internet principles apply solely to lawful content;
- Concerns about the FCC's jurisdiction over copyright law;
- The importance of respecting privacy and protecting free speech;
- Concerns about the possible implications of a non-discrimination principle on the jobs, incomes, benefits, and creative output of Americans employed in the creative and entertainment industries.
