This is to inform you that on Monday, July 19, 2010, Robert Irving, Russell Merbeth and the undersigned, on behalf of Leap Wireless International, Inc. and Cricket Communications, Inc. (“together, Cricket”), met with James Schlichting, Senior Deputy Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (“WTB”), and with Nese Guendelsberger, Paul Murray, Susan Singer, and Joel Taubenblatt of the WTB.

During this meeting, Cricket reiterated its support for prompt enactment of an automatic data roaming obligation as set forth in Cricket’s filings in the above-referenced roaming docket. Cricket emphasized the broad-based industry support for such an obligation and the need for a framework to discipline marketplace negotiations and to resolve data roaming disputes if necessary. Cricket also summarized its positions set forth in the Commission’s open Internet proceedings.
