
In compliance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's rules, the undersigned submits this *ex parte* notice relating to the above-captioned proceeding.

On August 11, 2010, Robert L. Allbritton, Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Allbritton Communications Company, met with Chairman Julius Genachowski. A portion of their discussion concerned the proposed acquisition of NBC by Comcast.

Mr. Allbritton noted the potentially ominous implications for NewsChannel 8, Allbritton's locally-owned, independent cable news channel, if the acquisition is permitted to close absent conditions that would protect the existence of NewsChannel 8 and similarly situated channels in direct, horizontal competition with NBC's owned and operated stations. They also discussed the potential impact that Comcast could have on the broadband carriage of Allbritton-related websites including POLITICO.com and TBD.com by unfettered distribution of favored websites controlled by or in partnership with the carrier.
