On October 19, 2010, Rick Cotton, Executive Vice President and General Counsel, NBC Universal, Inc., Kathryn A. Zachem, Vice President, Regulatory and State Legislative Affairs, Comcast Corporation, and the undersigned, Counsel for Comcast Corporation, (collectively, "Applicants") met with John Flynn, Senior Counsel to the Chairman on Transactions, and William Freedman and Jennifer Tatel of the Media Bureau.

Applicants reviewed their previously-made commitments and discussed the program access and program carriage rules and the reasons why there is no need to adopt any access or carriage conditions in this proceeding. Applicants also discussed the reasons why there is no need to impose conditions related to online distribution of video programming in this proceeding. Finally, Applicants discussed the public interest benefits that will result from the proposed transaction.
