On November 3, 2010, I met with Joshua Cinelli and Margaret McCarthy of Commissioner Michael J. Copps' office. I expressed my concerns regarding the proposed transaction between Comcast Corporation, General Electric Company, and NBC Universal, Inc.

Consistent with the documents filed in this docket, I discussed Consumers Union's concerns with the proposed transaction. Specifically, I expressed concern over the impact the transaction would have on competition, choice, and prices. I noted that the record indicated that the transaction would lead to higher cable and broadband prices. I also noted the record indicated that the transaction would also have a negative impact on the developing on-line video market.
