On November 23, 2010, David L. Cohen, Executive Vice President, and the undersigned of Comcast Corporation met with John Flynn, Senior Counsel to the Chairman for Transactions, and Rick Kaplan, Chief Counsel and Senior Legal Advisor to Chairman Genachowski, regarding Comcast's ongoing commitment to deploying broadband Internet service to more Americans and promoting adoption of broadband.

In our meeting, we discussed the status of broadband deployment in Comcast's footprint, detailing the significant efforts Comcast has undertaken to enable, expand, and improve broadband Internet service. We noted that Comcast has made substantial investments to bring broadband Internet service to over 99 percent of the homes its cable systems pass and discussed the characteristics of the remaining areas.

We also discussed Comcast's initiatives to promote broadband adoption and digital literacy. We described Comcast's long-standing partnership with community organizations like One Economy and in particular the Comcast Digital Connectors program. We also noted Comcast's continuing commitment to providing community public institutions, like libraries and schools, with broadband access and various initiatives to enhance digital literacy.

Finally, we reiterated Comcast's commitment to working with the Commission to address the goal of ensuring that all Americans have access to affordable broadband Internet service and can use broadband to achieve their full potential.
