The purpose of the meeting was to discuss how the public interest benefits of the proposed Comcast-NBCU transaction also will advance the goals being examined in the Commission's Future of Media proceeding. Applicants discussed both companies' historic and ongoing commitments to their local communities. Specifically, Applicants discussed Comcast's carriage of state public affairs networks, and NBCU's relationship with the voiceofsandiego.org and ways to encourage such cooperative arrangements with locally-focused non-profit news organizations.
