On December 6, 2010, the undersigned of Comcast Corporation met with Commissioner Mignon Clyburn and Dave Grimaldi, Angela Kronenberg, and Louis Peraertz, advisors to Commissioner Clyburn. We discussed the buildout status of Comcast's broadband network throughout its service area. I described Comcast's initiatives in the areas of broadband deployment and adoption and how Comcast might expand deployment and promote adoption in the future. We also discussed Comcast's minority contracting initiatives, including its success in that regard during the construction of its Philadelphia headquarters, as well as ways in which the company could educate the public on such efforts. Finally, we discussed the status of independent networks on Comcast's systems. I reiterated the significance of Comcast's commitment to add 10 independent networks in eight years, and described the factors that went into establishing the implementation benchmarks for this commitment.
