Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 9, 2010, the undersigned of Comcast Corporation met with Dave Grimaldi, Angela Kronenberg, and Louis Peraertz, advisors to Commissioner Clyburn. During the meeting, we discussed the buildout status of Comcast's broadband network throughout its service area. I described Comcast's initiatives in the areas of broadband deployment and adoption and how Comcast might expand deployment and promote adoption in the future. We also discussed the carriage of independent networks on Comcast's systems. I reiterated the significance of Comcast's commitment to add 10 independent networks in eight years and described the factors that went into establishing the implementation benchmarks for this commitment. In addition, we discussed channel neighborhooding, issues raised by Allbritton, and public, educational, and governmental ("PEG") programming; as to each of these, I summarized the filings and evidence (and, in the case of PEG programming, Applicants' commitments) previously presented by Comcast on the record.
