Dear Ms. Dortch,

On December 14, 2010 the undersigned met with FCC staffers William Freedman, Jennifer Tatel and John Flynn to discuss the benefits of the Comcast-NBCU Joint Venture for independent filmmakers. During this meeting, I talked about our experience with Comcast, and the company's strong support of independent programming (particularly from the independent film community). Comcast has worked with our company, the filmmakers, production entities and others with whom we work, and independent content creators generally, to maximize cross-promotional opportunities and to drive consumer awareness of high quality independent programming. I explained that I believe the NBCU Joint Venture will serve to expand opportunities for independent content, and that Comcast's willingness to collaborate with independent programmers over the more than ten years I have had experience working with the company is indicative of how we expect it will act going forward, in combination with NBCU. Accordingly, we asked that the FCC approve this transaction without delay.
