Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 13, 2010, David L. Cohen, Executive Vice President, Comcast Corporation; Rick Cotton, Executive Vice President and General Counsel, NBC Universal, Inc.; Ron Stern, Vice President and Senior Competition Counsel, General Electric Company; and the undersigned (collectively, "Applicants") met with Edward Lazarus, Chief of Staff to the Chairman; Rick Kaplan, Chief Counsel and Senior Legal Advisor to the Chairman; John Flynn, Senior Counsel to the Chairman on Transactions; and Paul de Sa, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis. The undersigned also met separately on December 13, 2010 with Rick Kaplan and John Flynn on the same substantive issues described below.

Applicants discussed a number of potential conditions that have been raised in this proceeding, including conditions related to program access, exclusivity, online video distribution, and broadband Internet services. Applicants explained why the record in this proceeding, along with the voluntary commitments Applicants have already offered, render such conditions unnecessary. Applicants described the complex and dynamic nature of the marketplace today and underscored that regulations in such a marketplace could have serious unintended consequences for competition, consumers, and the Comcast and NBC Universal businesses. Consistent with their prior written submissions, Applicants pointed out that the marketplace is highly competitive, Applicants will have low market shares in any relevant market post transaction, and competition, rather than detailed regulatory conditions, would best serve the public interest.
