Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, DISH Network L.L.C ("DISH") submits this letter summarizing meetings on Tuesday, January 4, 2011 with Dave Grimaldi and Angela Kronenberg in Commissioner Clyburn's office, and on Wednesday, January 5, 2011 with Joshua Cinelli in Commissioner Copps' office. Present on behalf of DISH were Jeffrey Blum, Senior Vice President and Deputy General Counsel, and Alison Minea, Corporate Counsel.

During the meetings, DISH urged several merger conditions that it believes are necessary to protect the public interest and competition, including, but not limited to: (1) a wholesale broadband condition; (2) program access, temporary standstill and arbitration conditions that apply to all Comcast-NBCU affiliated content, including in the online arena; and (3) strong broadband conditions.
