Re: American Cable Association (“ACA”) Notice of Ex Parte Presentation; In the Matter of Applications of Comcast Corporation, General Electric Company and NBC Universal, Inc. for Consent to Assign Licenses or Transfer Control of Licenses; MB Docket No. 10-56.

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 6, 2011, Matthew Polka and Ross Lieberman, American Cable Association; Thomas Cohen, Kelley Drye & Warren, LLP; William Rogerson, Northwestern University; and the undersigned, participated in meeting via telephone conference with John Flynn, Senior Counsel to the Chairman for Transactions, regarding the above-captioned proceeding. Participants once again discussed conditions under consideration for adoption by the Commission concerning special relief for small multichannel video programming distributors (“MVPDs”). Consistent with its previous filings in this docket, ACA discussed its concerns with the proposed conditions for small MVPDs, as we understood them.¹ Moreover, ACA stressed the need for relief that will work in practice to ameliorate the substantial impact of the horizontal and vertical harms of the proposed Comcast-NBCU transaction on small MVPDs.²
