On January 9, 2011, William P. Rogerson, Professor, Northwestern University, and the undersigned had a phone conversation with Angela Kronenberg, Wireline Legal Advisor to Commissioner Mignon Clyburn, in regard to the above-referenced docket. Professor Rogerson and I discussed the inadequacies of the conditions proposed by the Chairman to mitigate harms to smaller multichannel video programming distributors (MVPDs) from the proposed combination of Comcast and NBC Universal, as indicated by press and analyst reports. Moreover, we talked about remedies that would work effectively for smaller MVPDs. The views expressed were consistent with ACA’s past *ex parte* filings.
