Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, DISH Network L.L.C ("DISH") submits this letter summarizing two telephone calls on Friday, January 7, 2011 with Joshua Cinelli in Commissioner Copps' office and Angela Kronenberg in Commissioner Clyburn's office.

During the telephone calls, DISH expressed concern over any condition on the merger that would allow pay-TV providers to invoke program access, standstill, and arbitration conditions only when Comcast/NBCU national programming channels are offered as a bundle. In order to protect consumers and competition, all of Comcast/NBCU's affiliated content should be offered on a standalone basis.
