Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 11, 2011, the undersigned, counsel to Avail-TVN, spoke by telephone with Joshua Cinelli, Media Advisor to Commissioner Copps.

During the telephone call, I reiterated the issues addressed in Avail-TVN's filings in this docket. In particular, I expressed Avail-TVN's concern that absent appropriate safeguards, the proposed transaction, through the addition of NBCU content, would provide Comcast an even greater ability and incentive to harm competition for video delivery service providers. In order to address these potential harms, we discussed Avail-TVN's request that the Commission require all Comcast-controlled entities to provide equal access and reasonable prices for all NBCU and Comcast-controlled content to all video delivery service competitors in all formats. We also discussed that the Commission should impose several additional remedies that have been described in prior Avail-TVN filings in this proceeding.
