

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 11, 2011, Ross Lieberman, American Cable Association, and the undersigned had a phone conversation with Krista Witanowski, legal advisor to Commissioner Meredith Atwell Baker, in regard to the above-referenced docket. Mr. Lieberman discussed the inadequacies of the conditions proposed by the Chairman to mitigate harms to smaller multichannel video programming distributors (MVPDs) from the proposed combination of Comcast and NBC Universal, as indicated by press and analyst reports. He also discussed remedies that would work effectively for smaller MVPDs. The views expressed were consistent with ACA’s past *ex parte* filings.
