On Thursday, January 13, 2011, Gregory Babyak, Director of Government Affairs for Bloomberg L.P. (Bloomberg), Markham Erickson, Counsel for the Coalition for Competition in Media, and the undersigned, counsel for Bloomberg, met with Dave Grimaldi, Chief of Staff and Legal Advisor to Commissioner Mignon Clyburn, and Angela Kronenberg, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Clyburn. During this meeting, we discussed the merger and transfer of control of licenses of NBC Universal, Inc. to Comcast Corporation. The discussion focused on conditions that would be necessary to mitigate the competitive harms identified by Bloomberg in the event the Commission approves the merger, including the structure of a neighborhooding requirement.
