On July 12, 2011, Lynn Refer, Chief Executive Officer, Telecom Transport Management, Inc. ("TTM") met by teleconference with Peter Trachtenberg, Kathy Harris, Melissa Tye, Patrick DeGraba, Susan Singer, Tom Peters, and Paul Murray of the Wireless Bureau and Jim Bird, Neil Dellar, and Virginia Metallo, of the Office of General Counsel, to discuss the above-referenced proceeding.

TTM's comments were consistent with those set forth in its Ex Parte Reply Comments, filed June 21, 2011 in this Docket, and discussed the trend towards AT&T purchasing backhaul exclusively from the Verizon in the territory in which Verizon is the incumbent LEC, the need of independent backhaul providers to have enough wireless customers to be able to achieve economies of scale, the extent to which competitive bidding is used by wireless providers to purchase backhaul, and the importance of T-Mobile's purchase volume to independent backhaul providers' ability to serve other wireless customers.
