Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 8, 2011 Dean Brenner of QUALCOMM Incorporated (“Qualcomm”) and the undersigned spoke via telephone with Rick Kaplan, Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, and the undersigned spoke with Edward Lazarus, Chief of Staff to the Chairman. On August 9, 2011 Mr. Brenner spoke with Mr. Lazarus via telephone. On each call the parties discussed the proposed assignment of licenses from Qualcomm to AT&T. Mr. Brenner and I explained the substantial and indisputable public interest benefits of the proposed transaction, and how the transaction will advance the objectives of FCC policy, as explained in the joint Qualcomm/AT&T Public Interest Statement in this proceeding.¹ We also reiterated the points made in the Joint Opposition to Joint Motion to Consolidate.² Finally, we explained that in order to achieve the public interest benefits from the transaction, the FCC should approve the proposed transaction as soon as possible.
