Re: **Notice of Ex Parte Presentation:** *Applications of AT&T Mobility Spectrum LLC and Qualcomm Inc. for Consent to the Assignment of Lower 700 MHz Band Licenses, WT Docket No. 11-18*

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 10, 2011 Dean Brenner of QUALCOMM Incorporated (“Qualcomm”) and the undersigned met with Rick Kaplan, Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, and Paul De Sa, Chief of the Office of Strategic Planning & Policy Analysis. In addition, on August 11 Paul Jacobs of Qualcomm spoke via telephone with FCC Chairman Julius Genachowski. In both the meeting and on the telephone call the parties discussed the proposed assignment of licenses from Qualcomm to AT&T. We explained the substantial and indisputable public interest benefits of the transaction as described in the joint Qualcomm/AT&T Public Interest Statement,¹ including how the transaction will result in: (1) much-needed spectrum being put to a higher and better use in furtherance of the FCC’s core spectrum goals, (2) the introduction of the important new supplemental downlink technology in the U.S. ahead of other countries, and (3) a channel-bonding model that the FCC can use to make better use of other non-paired spectrum. Furthermore, Mr. Brenner and I reiterated the points made in the Joint Opposition to Joint Motion to Consolidate.² Mr. Jacobs and Mr. Brenner explained the need to complete review of the proposed transaction as soon as possible to realize the described public interest benefits.
