Re: **Notice of Ex Parte Presentation:** *Applications of AT&T Mobility Spectrum LLC and Qualcomm Inc. for Consent to the Assignment of Lower 700 MHz Band Licenses, WT Docket No. 11-18*

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 18, 2011, Robert Jarrin of QUALCOMM Incorporated (“Qualcomm”) met with Edward Lazarus, Chief of Staff to Chairman Genachowski. Mr. Jarrin and Mr. Lazarus discussed the proposed assignment of licenses from Qualcomm to AT&T. Mr. Jarrin described the substantial public interest benefits of the proposed transaction, and how the transaction will advance the FCC’s policy objectives, as set forth in the Joint Qualcomm/AT&T Public Interest Statement in this proceeding.¹ In particular, Mr. Jarrin explained that the transaction will advance the FCC’s core spectrum goals by enabling the use of unpaired spectrum, not being used today, with new supplemental downlink technology to deliver faster downloads and support a greater number of users than is possible with existing technology; and by extending U.S. global leadership in mobile technology, since approval of the transaction will allow the world’s first deployment of this new technology to occur in the U.S. Mr. Jarrin also discussed the points made in the Joint Opposition to Joint Motion to Consolidate,² and explained the importance of the Commission’s completing review of the proposed transaction as soon as possible in order to realize its public interest benefits.
