Dear Ms. Dortch:

On September 16, 2011, Catherine Bohigian of Cablevision Systems Corporation, and the undersigned on behalf of Cablevision, met with Commission Staff concerning the above-referenced proceeding. Attending the meeting were Renata Hesse, Rick Kaplan, Jim Schlichting, Paul Murray, and Patrick DeGraba.

In this meeting, Cablevision reiterated the viewpoint expressed in its comments. *See* Comments of Cablevision Systems Corporation, WT Docket No. 11-65 (May 31, 2011); Reply Comments of Cablevision Systems Corporation, WT Docket No. 11-65 (June 20, 2011). Cablevision noted, specifically, that AT&T's acquisition of T-Mobile would eliminate an important source of retail competition in the market for mobile voice and data. *See* Cablevision Comments at 14-15. Furthermore, and of significance to Cablevision, because of the unique role that T-Mobile plays in facilitating entry by partnering with other potential providers, the proposed transaction would substantially impair entry and diminish long run opportunities for innovation, investment, and competition from providers like Cablevision in the market for mobile voice and data services, especially integrated "quad play" offerings from firms capable of combining terrestrial broadband, voice, video with state of the art mobile services. *See id.* at 10-14; Cablevision Reply Comments at 5-11. Accordingly, Cablevision argued that the Commission should either reject the transaction or else put in place enforceable conditions to mitigate the harm to the market. *See* Cablevision Comments at 15-18; Cablevision Reply Comments at 11-15.
