Re: **Notice of Oral *Ex Parte* Communication**

Applications of D&E Investments, Inc. and New Cingular Wireless PCS, LLC (ULS File No. 0004448347), Windstream Iowa Communications, Inc. and AT&T Mobility Spectrum LLC (ULS File No. 0004681771), and Windstream Lakedale Inc. and AT&T Mobility Spectrum LLC (ULS File No. 0004681773); WT Docket No. 11-18; WT Docket No. 11-65

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On Monday, September 26, 2011, the undersigned, counsel to D&E Investments, Inc., Windstream Iowa Communications, Inc., and Windstream Lakedale, Inc. (collectively, "Windstream"), spoke with James Schlichting, Senior Deputy Bureau Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau, regarding the status of the three pending wireless assignment of license applications referenced above.¹

Specifically, Windstream urged the Commission to complete its processing of the subject applications. Windstream reiterated that approval of the applications will serve the public interest, and stated that there is no compelling reason to further delay Commission action. Windstream expressed concern that the Department of Justice's recent decision to oppose AT&T's acquisition of T-Mobile could result in further, protracted delays.² Finally, Windstream
