This letter provides notice of an ex parte communication with staff of the Commission in connection with the above-referenced proceedings. I represent Simplexity and Versa Capital.

On September 27, 2011, Andy Zeinfeld of Simplexity, Paul Halpern of Versa Capital, Dr. Michael Pelcovits of MiCRA Economics, and Eric Cochran and Steve Bradbury of Dechert LLP met with Renata Hesse, Senior Counsel to the Chairman; Austin Schlick, General Counsel of the Commission; Greg Rosston of the Office of Strategic Planning; Jim Bird of the Office of General Counsel; and Patrick DeGraba of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the harmful impact that the proposed merger could have on the independent online distribution channel for wireless service and handsets (the "Channel"). At the meeting, we discussed the attached presentation and press release. We described how the Channel benefits consumers through lower handset prices and efficient opportunities for convenient comparison shopping among the major national wireless providers. We explained how AT&T's recent actions to exit from the Channel are harming consumers by denying these benefits. We also explained how the merger threatens to exacerbate these harms by likely reducing the number of national carriers whose service and handsets are marketed over the Channel and by significantly increasing AT&T's ability to suppress the Channel and permanently eliminate the consumer benefits provided by the Channel.
