Re: *Applications of Cellco Partnership d/b/a/ Verizon Wireless, SpectrumCo, LLC, and Cox TMI Wireless, LLC for Consent to Assign Wireless Licenses, WT Docket No. 12-4*

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Yesterday, Free Press, Media Access Project, Public Knowledge, and The Greenlining Institute (the “Public Interest Parties”) submitted a request that the Commission promptly direct the Applicants to produce into the record herein complete and unredacted copies of the Commercial Agreements amongst the parties.¹ Although the Applicants have submitted the Commercial Agreements into the record as either Confidential or Highly Confidential documents subject to the stringent protections set forth in the Commission's Protective Orders, they nevertheless subjected those materials to "redactions . . . relating to pricing, compensation, and related provisions.”

The Commission put the Protective Orders in place precisely to address potential concerns about preserving the confidentiality of submitted materials and any proprietary business information they may contain. Those orders are more than adequate for this purpose, without the need for (or any provision for) redactions. As a result of the incomplete submissions by the Applicants, neither the Commission nor interested parties have an adequate basis upon which to assess the public interest implications of the proposed transactions. The parties represented below therefore concur with the request by the Public Interest Parties that the Commission should suspend both the pleading cycle in this proceeding and the informal 180-day “transaction clock,” and reset them to zero once the Applicants have provided full disclosure of their arrangements.
