Dear Ms. Dortch:

On March 22, 2012, Cellco Partnership d/b/a Verizon Wireless filed its response to the FCC Information and Discovery Request of March 8, 2012 in the above-referenced docket. That response has been updated and supplemented in subsequent filings. By this filing, Verizon Wireless is providing further documents in response to the FCC's Information and Discovery Request including:

- As requested by FCC staff, a supplemental production of all documents produced to the Department of Justice ("DOJ") in connection with the DOJ's Second Request for which William H. Stone is named as the custodian or is listed in the metadata as the sender or recipient. Pursuant to discussions with the FCC, these documents are not being provided as responsive to particular requests from the FCC's March 8 Information and Discovery Request, and therefore are being provided without FCC specification metadata. The additional documents have been placed on a disk titled "VZW-009."
- Also as discussed with FCC staff, given the subject matter of the requests to which
 these documents are responsive, and in order to expedite this production, all documents
 have been temporarily designated "Highly Confidential" under the Second Protective

Order in this docket.² Verizon Wireless will shortly provide a database overlay that will downgrade that designation from "Highly Confidential" to either "Confidential" (as defined under the *Protective Order* in this docket) or "public," where appropriate, based on a review now underway.

A privilege log for the added documents, as well as an updated index associated with that privilege log and the prior privilege logs containing descriptions of the individuals referenced in the privilege logs. The supplemental privilege log has been provided on the encrypted hard drive containing the supplemental production under filename "VZW_009_Priv_Log_HIGHLY_CONFIDENTIAL.xls." The index has been provided in the same hard drive with filename "VZW_Job_Descriptions_05102012_HIGHLY_CONFIDENTIAL.xls." These documents contain descriptions of privileged communications or specific, individualized information about particular Verizon Wireless and outside counsel, and therefore should be treated as "Highly Confidential" under the Second Protective Order.
