Dear Ms. Dortch:

On January 7, 2013, Deutsche Telekom AG (“Deutsche Telekom”) and T-Mobile USA, Inc. (“T-Mobile USA”) (together, the “Parties”) filed their response to the FCC Information and Document Request of December 20, 2012 (the “Response”) in the above-referenced docket. As part of that Response, the Parties provided copies of T-Mobile USA documents that were provided to the Department of Justice (“DOJ”) as required by Request 16 of the Information Request.

At the request of FCC staff, the Parties hereby supplement their response by providing additional documents provided to the DOJ on January 18, 2013. On January 18, T-Mobile USA provided to the DOJ certain back-up documentation covering Compass Lexecon’s econometric analysis of MetroPCS churn rates with respect to price and quality metrics as well as Compass Lexecon’s specific calculations of marginal cost savings.

The documents are being provided to the FCC in the same format they were provided to the DOJ. Accordingly, certain documents are being produced in Summation Enterprise load files on a CD-ROM labeled “TM002.” Additional data is being provided in its native form on a CD-ROM labeled TMUS-DEN-90000005.


