**ORDER**

By the Deputy Chief, Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau:

1. Consistent with the Wireline Competition Bureau's (Bureau) decision in the *Barrow County School District Order*,<sup>1</sup> we grant the appeal filed by Cornwall-Lebanon School District (Cornwall-Lebanon) of a decision by the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) that reduced funding from the E-rate program for funding year 2010 because Cornwall-Lebanon inadvertently listed the wrong service start date information on its FCC Form 486.<sup>2</sup> As the Bureau found in *Barrow County School District Order*, minor mistakes such as this do not warrant the complete rejection of this application given that the applicant made a procedural error and did not violate a Commission rule.<sup>3</sup> Therefore, we find good cause to grant the appeal and remand the underlying application to USAC for further action consistent with this order.

2. ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED that, pursuant to the authority contained in sections 1-4 and 254 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 151-154 and 254, and sections 0.91, 0.291, 1.3, and 54.722(a) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.91, 0.291, 1.3 and 54.722(a), the Requests for Review filed by Cornwall-Lebanon School District, Lebanon, Pennsylvania IS GRANTED and the application IS REMANDED to USAC for further consideration in accordance with the terms of this order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, pursuant to sections 1-4 and 254 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 151-154 and 254, and sections 0.91, 0.291, and 54.722(a) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.91, 0.291, 54.722(a), that USAC SHALL COMPLETE its review of the underlying application and ISSUE an award or a denial based on a complete review and analysis no later than 60 calendar days from the release date of this order.
