By the Acting Chief, Wireline Competition Bureau:

- 1. In this Order, we dismiss a number of pending petitions as moot. In the *USF/ICC Transformation Order and FNPRM*, the Commission adopted many reforms addressing a wide range of high-cost universal service and access charge matters. As a result of the *USF/ICC Transformation Order and FNPRM*, the issues raised in certain petitions pending at the time the *Order* was adopted are moot. In each case, the issues raised in the petition were addressed in the *USF/ICC Transformation Order and FNPRM*, or the relief requested is no longer relevant in light of the regulatory changes included in the *Order*. For these reasons, we dismiss the petitions.
- 2. ACCORDINGLY, IT IS ORDERED that, pursuant to the authority contained in sections 1-5 and 254 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. §§ 151-155 and 254, and sections 0.91, 0.291, and 1.429 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.91, 0.291, and 1.429, the petitions filed by petitioners listed in the Appendix ARE DISMISSED AS MOOT.
