By the Chief, Market Disputes Resolution Division, Enforcement Bureau:

1. On September 5, 2014, Forman Seeley Fountain Inc. (FSF) filed a complaint against tw telecom holdings, inc.  $(TWT)^1$  pursuant to Section 208 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended (Act).<sup>2</sup>

2. On January 20, 2015, FSF filed a motion seeking dismissal of the complaint on the ground that the parties have reached a settlement of their dispute.<sup>3</sup> FSF further stated that counsel for TWT reviewed the Motion and consents to FSF's request.

3. We are satisfied that granting the Motion will serve the public interest by promoting the private resolution of disputes and by eliminating the need for further expenditure of time and resources by the parties and the Commission.

4. Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED**, pursuant to sections 4(i), 4(j), and 208 of the Act, 47 U.S.C. §§ 154(i), 154(j), and 208, and the authority delegated in sections 0.111, 0.311, and 1.720–1.736 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. §§ 0.111, 0.311, and 1.720–1.736, that the Motion is **GRANTED**.

5. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED**, pursuant to sections 4(i), 4(j), and 208 of the Act, 47 U.S.C. §§ 154(i), 154(j), and 208, and the authority delegated in sections 0.111, 0.311,
