**PUBLIC SAFETY AND HOMELAND SECURITY BUREAU ANNOUNCES
REGION 33 (OHIO) PUBLIC SAFETY REGIONAL PLANNING COMMITTEES TO HOLD
700 MHZ AND 800 MHZ NPSPAC REGIONAL PUBLIC SAFETY PLANNING MEETINGS**

The Region 33 (Ohio)¹ Public Safety Regional Planning Committees (RPCs) will hold two planning meetings on Wednesday, September 9, 2015. Beginning at 10 a.m., the 700 MHz RPC will convene at the Holiday Inn Worthington, 7007 North High Street, Worthington, Ohio.²

Both Region 33 RPC meetings are open to the public. All eligible public safety providers in Region 33 may utilize these frequencies. It is essential that eligible public safety agencies in all areas of government, including state, municipality, county, and Native American Tribal be represented in order to ensure that each agency's future spectrum needs are considered in the allocation process. Administrators who are not oriented in the communications field should delegate someone with this knowledge to attend, participate, and represent their agency's needs.
