Network Change:

Frontier Communications announces that it is retiring copper feeder plant as part of an on-going City of League City project to widen Calder Road, Butler Road and Turner Street. The distribution plant copper will be replaced with fiber (FIOS.)

Description of Reasonably Foreseeable Impact of the Planned Changes:

After the project, there will be no copper loop distribution facilities between Frontier’s League City, TX Central Office and the affected customer premises listed below. Frontier is planning to replace the existing copper loops with fiber drops as part of this project.

After the planned network changes are implemented, Frontier will (1) no longer offer services over copper facilities; and (2) cease maintaining the copper facilities.

Customers will have the opportunity to access services based on the FiOS prices, terms, and conditions. Further information is available at www.frontier.com.

In accordance with FCC Rule 47 C.F.R. § 51.332(b)(2), all carriers that are currently interconnected at this Central Office location are being notified of the upgrade.
