Why an Experimental License is Necessary

An experimental license is required to support experimental testing and development of telemetry transmitters that will operate in the C band.

Test Description

The purpose of this experiment is to demonstrate the capabilities of RF transmitting equipment to support the transfer of telemetry data in the C band. This testing will verify operations from aircraft to ground stations during actual flight test events. Operations must prove that transmissions will satisfy current flight testing requirements. This includes a range of 250 miles from the aircraft to the ground station. Various transmitters will be evaluated.

This work will support verification of the 4400-4950 MHz band allocated for telemetry use during World Radio Conference (WRC) 2007.
