



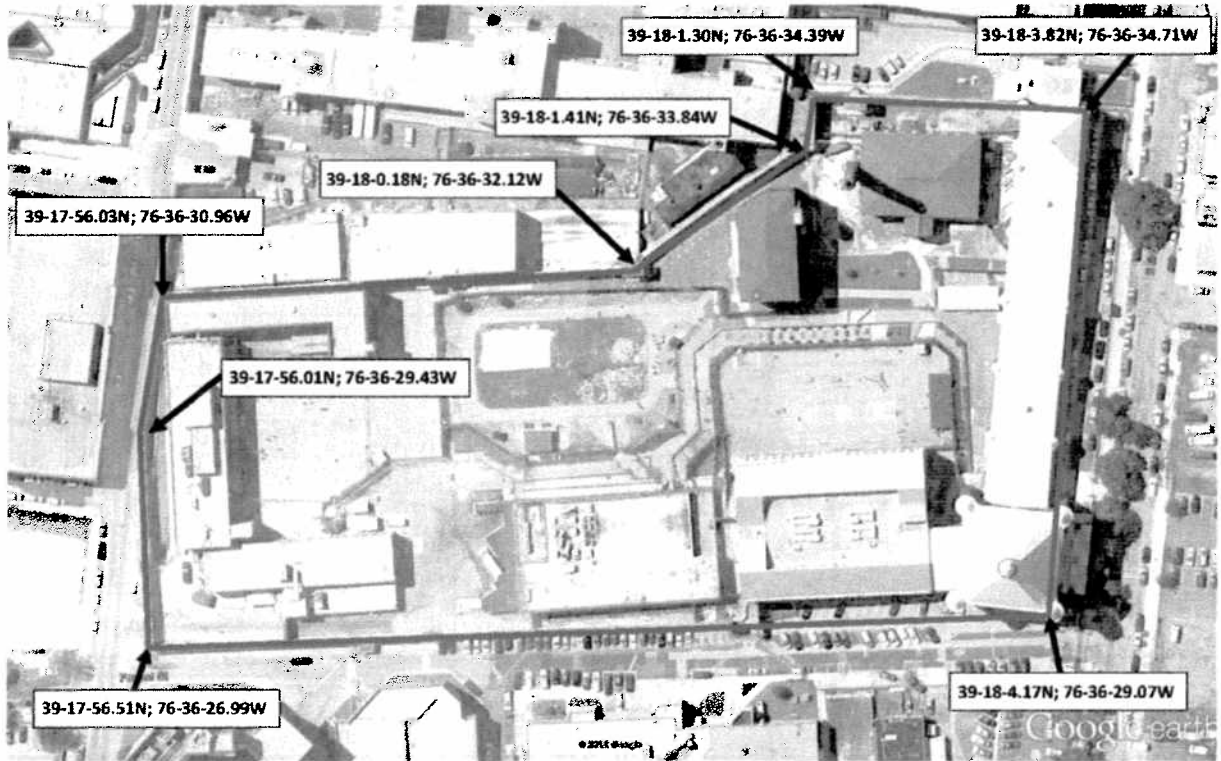

*Re: Letter of Concurrence and Support for Tecore Government Service
 Managed Access Deployment in Baltimore, MD - File No. 0735-EX-ST-2012*

Dear Sir or Madam:

Pursuant to Part 5 of the Rules of the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”), 47 C.F.R. Part 5, New Cingular Wireless PCS LLC, AT&T Mobility II LLC, and AT&T Mobility Spectrum LLC (collectively “AT&T Mobility”) hereby submits this letter of concurrence with the associated application File No. 0735-EX-ST-2012 for an experimental Special Temporary Authorization (“STA”) in Baltimore, Maryland at the Metropolitan Transition Center (“MTC”) located at 954 Forest Street, filed by Tecore Government Services, LLC (“Tecore”). Tecore seeks to deploy their proprietary technology at the MTC facility, and has negotiated long-term leases with the wireless carriers in the area, including AT&T Mobility. This experimental STA is intended to provide operating authority solely within the boundaries of the MTC facility, identified in the figure on the next page, during the initial set up and demonstration period for the system through January 2013.

Tecore is working cooperatively with AT&T Mobility and has agreed to coordinate the use of the above-listed spectrum with AT&T Mobility and will avoid harmful interference while conducting its operations. In addition, Tecore has agreed to immediately cease operations should any interference issues arise during the demonstrations.

AT&T Mobility desires to support Tecore's technology and therefore agrees to permit Tecore to use the listed spectrum for a period up to January 1, 2013, after the grant of the associated application. AT&T Mobility supports the grant of the associated Tecore application for an experimental STA to operate its Managed Access system for a period up to January 1, 2013 after the grant of the associated application.
