Hi Hemant,

For Dish's planned Category-C trials Federated Wireless can provide the following professional service support

- The SAS cannot not support registration of CBSDs with a transmit power higher than what is allowed under the FCC's rules.
- However, with DISH provided installation parameters of the trial devices, Federated can manually (offline) assist DISH to avoid interference to nearby protected operations, by:
 - Identifying incumbents in the devices' neighborhood; and
 - Determining availability of GAA channels in the devices' neighborhood on a regular basis.
- DISH will be responsible for operating the test devices in accordance with the terms of the FCC experimental authorization and any other waivers received from protected users.
- If DISH has PAL channels covering the area covered by the experimental authorization, it is recommended that they operate on those frequencies.
