Dear Ms. Dortch:

Pursuant to Section 1.65 of the Federal Communications Commission's ("Commission") rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.65, True Anomaly, Inc. ("True Anomaly") hereby updates certain information furnished in connection with the above-referenced application for special temporary authority to launch and operate the Jackal space vehicles as part of the Demo-1 mission.¹

In the Application, True Anomaly noted the Demo-1 mission was scheduled to launch as part of SpaceX's Transporter-9 mission scheduled for October 2023.² Due to unexpected supply chain delays, the Demo-1 mission is now expected to launch as part of the Transporter-10 mission scheduled for February 2024. Accordingly, True Anomaly now seeks special temporary authority for six months, for a period commencing on February 1, 2024.
