University of Utah and Salt Lake City PAWR proposal


I am confirming the intent of the University of Utah Facilities Management to collaborate in and provide support for the PAWR proposal entitled, "POWDER: Platform for Open Wireless Data-Driven Experimental Research" from the University of Utah/Salt Lake City team. If the proposal is selected for funding, the University of Utah Facilities Management will collaborate and/or commit resources as detailed in the proposal and described below.

The University of Utah Facilities Management will specifically:

- Provide secure access to maps for fiber, conduit, power contact points, and other physical plant infrastructure necessary to the project.
- Provide access to vehicles from the University's vehicle fleet to serve as "mobile couriers" for the POWDER platform.
- Provide access to University buildings to enable rooftop deployment of antennas and equipment associated with the POWDER platform.
- Work with the POWDER team to find a suitable deployment strategy for their proposed "dense base station deployment" approach.
- Work with the POWDER team to facilitate any campus permits required for work by contractors or team members.

Facilities Management will oversee deployment of pertinent POWDER equipment on campus and guide the POWDER team in following relevant University of Utah policies and regulations.
