O3b Limited (“SES”) confirms that it is working with Johns Hopkins University’s Applied Physics Laboratory (“JHUAPL”) on NASA’s Polylingual Experimental Terminal Program. Under that Program, an in-orbit demonstration is anticipated whereby transmissions will be made from JHUAPL’s experimental terminal in Low Earth Orbit to the O3b Medium Earth Orbit constellation (call sign S2935) in the Ka-band frequencies. All such transmissions will be arranged in coordination with and with the approval of SES’s network operations center. Moreover, all operations will be conducted in accordance with the terms of the experimental authorization on a non-interference, non-protected basis, consistent with the Commission’s rules.
