February 8th, 2024 to February 19th, 2024 inclusive.

This application proposes the use of certain microwave bands in Indianapolis, Indiana for terrestrial only, short-range communications in support of the NBA All Star 2024, and associated activities as an international and domestic satellite broadcast, cablecast, and large scale event.

Devices will be exclusively deployed within the structures of Lucas Oil Stadium, Gainbridge Fieldhouse, and the Indiana Convention Center.

Should any authorized user of the subject bands report interference during the proposed operations, operation on that channel will immediately cease and not resume unless and until the interference complaint is resolved.

Applicant will comply with the following conditions:

- (1) The applicant is aware that other stations are licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the applicant will immediately shut down.
- (2) The applicant acknowledges that operation is subject to coordination with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE) frequency coordinator.
- (3) The applicant will receive consent from the incumbent AWS (Service code: AH) and PCS (Service code: CY) license holders in the proposed area prior to operations.
